Our Circle of Care

Services: Our clients: children aged to 13 years; **Our service:** community based; **Our service focus:** child's emotional, behavioural and social growth.

Therapy Programs: Assessments, Individual and Group therapies provided by Psychologists; Occupational Therapists; Speech and Language Pathologists.

Family/Team Liaison: Family Health Support Workers work with the family. They can provide practical implementation of therapy programs set by the therapist and general health and community support programs.



Group programs

Positive Parenting

Groups are provided at our Centres or in the school when requested. Each group meets weekly over a six week period. Evening groups are held where necessary to enable maximum participation by working families

Language Development

Effective communication skills are the goals of these groups offered to primary school age children.

Support Groups

Parents are encouraged to meet in an informal group setting to develop confidence in resolving conflicts and managing children's difficult behaviours. Support groups for parents with children exhibiting Attention Deficit Disorder are frequently requested.


*Group programs vary with each service centre.

Program supervision and support

Quality assurance is maintained through Bush Children's mentoring and supervision program, which is offered to all employees. Periodic visits by senior therapists and management are undertaken to monitor program implementation. Access to the latest processes, research findings, journals and articles specific to children's disorders through the internet and videoconferencing has been strengthened
